## YOUNG PEOPLE FROM THE EU GOT TOGETHER THANKS TO THE PROJECT DURING...

... **7 community dialogues events** in the Netherlands, Italy, Belgium, Hungary, Portugal, Germany and Spain. The goal was to generate a debate on the future of Europe and to develop a stronger sense of ownership to the EU as well as ways to make it more democratic and youth-oriented. During these events, the U4EU Documentary "What Does Europe Mean to Me?" was projected, while informative lectures and workshops were organised.

... the **Info Day in Athens** on the 30th of May. CSOs from Greece were invited in order to discuss about the importance of volunteering in international, european and local level and to present their work. Young people from all nine partner countries participated in this event and they shared their experiences and also got informed about the European Solidarity Corps. It has been a great opportunity to foster dialogue and solidarity within European youth.

... the **workshop for youth which was held in Sofia** (Bulgaria) on the 13th of June. 32 young people from all the partner countries and also from the USA, Armenia, Ukraine and Bulgaria participated in this workshop, with the aim to give the opportunity to young Europeans to draft recommendations on the future of the EU. They had the opportunity to discuss various topics concerning the EU and climate change, the integration of migrants / refugees, youth participation and the countering hate speech

## THE LAST STEPS WILL BE...

... the **screening of the U4EU Final Documentary in the European Parliament** in order to give voice to the European youth citizens and reinforce their participation in the EU. The goal is for European decision makers to listen to young people's opinions on the EU and adapt their choices and rulings accordingly.

... the issuing of a summary of the Community Dialogues' results in the form of an **e-publication, entitled "What does Europe Mean for the European Youth: Views from the Field"**. This e-publication will be widely disseminated throughout Europe to set an example for future discussions between young European actors.

... the **final event** will be organized in **Athens** (Greece) in July, with the participation of young people, relevant stakeholders and our partners from all the participating countries to give closure to the project and celebrate together.
